

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Upon a recommendation by Dr. Martin, Mr. Baldwin moved, seconded by Mr. DiFilippo, that the housing pattern of the secondary schools for the school year 1967-68 be as follows:

7th grade	- Henderson Road School
8th, 9th grades	- Junior High School
10th, 11th, and 12th grades	- Senior High School

Those voting in favor were: Mr. Tyson, Mrs. Boldt, Mr. Pence, Mr. DiFilippo, Mr. Baldwin, Mr. Schrack, Mr. Ivey, and Mr. Peters.

Dr. Martin reported that the District has received approval from the Department of Public Instruction for its application for NDEA funds in the amount of \$12,540.00., with 50% of this amount reimbursable. This total is the District's entitlement of NDEA funds.

Dr. Martin reported that the special project under Title III of ESEA in which Dr. Stull is working is practically complete and will be forwarded to the proper officials in the Department of Public Instruction before the due date of January 9, 1966. Dr. Stull's project concerns preparation of written guides for field trips as well as an improvement of the Administration of such educational field trip experiences with a recommended modification of a school bus to make such field trips more effective.

Dr. Martin gave the following status report of the Junior High School Addition and subsequent approvals of the project.

1. December 5 - Appraisal by Dr. Gasser, Pat Villa, and Dr. Martin;
2. December 7 - Final Approval of Plans & Specifications;
3. December 15 - Appraisal approval;
4. December 15 - Final project based upon bid costs (\$2,750,000.00)

REMARKS BY THE PRESIDENT

Mr. Peters stated that the Directors desire that the Administration begin working on a five-year program which shall include utilization of school buildings, school population growth, evaluation of personnel, and curriculum development. Mr. Peters also requested that the Administration prepare an outline of items to be included in the five-year program with definite lines of those responsible for areas in the program; with this information to be prepared by the Administration for distribution to the Directors at its January meeting.

Mr. Peters appointed Mr. Clifford H. Pence as Chairman of a new standing committee which shall be called the Public Relations Committee, with Mrs. Boldt and Mr. Ivey to be members of this committee. The purpose of the committee shall be to explore the total district needs in public relations as well as to evaluate our present program and make recommendations for the future.
