The Board of Community Assistance reviewed all applications over a two-month period of time and awarded organizations, such as yours because of its need-based community issues. Program and project grants support specific efforts through which an organization carries out its mission, including new or existing programs and projects, which can be ongoing or limited to a specific time period.

Since your award is below and up to \$5,000, no match is required. The BCA rules stipulate that funds provided to organizations may be audited to ensure that they are used for the purpose for which they are granted. As such, the BCA requests that you keep all receipts related to the use of these funds and if possible, your organization might want to consider opening up a separate account just for the BCA funds. As you also may recall from the Grant Application process, part of receiving the BCA Grant included your willingness and agreement to provide a year-end summary of the proposed project and use of funds as compared to the project plan. This report is due by December 31, 2015.

Again, please accept our congratulations and gratitude for all of your civic-minded services that have a positive impact on the health, safety, and welfare of the Upper Merion Township community.
